What is the MINTWG?

- **The MINTWG is made up of seniors from across the Intelligence Community (IC) that are chartered to foster collaboration and promote the use of Multi-Intelligence (Multi-INT) techniques**
- **MINTWG membership includes CIA, DHS, DIA, FBI, NGA, NSA, and NRO**
- **Associate membership – DOE**

Multi-INT: “Sharing and integrating activities among diverse intelligence disciplines that satisfy customer needs with the goal of enhanced accuracy, confidence level, timeliness, and clarity”

MINTWG History

- **Director of Central Intelligence (DCI) was congressionally mandated to create and manage a program in the IC to promote Multi-INT techniques**
- **In 2001, the DCI appointed the Assistant Director of Central Intelligence for Analysis (ADCI/A) as the IC Multi-INT advocate and also established the MINTWG**
- **In 2005, MINTWG responsibility transitioned to ODNI/A**

MINTWG Responsibilities

- **Promote inter-agency collaboration and Multi-INT techniques**
- **Administer the Multi-INT Experiment Program**
 - Evaluate results of experiments performed
 - Recommend transition of Multi-INT activities
- **Establish mechanisms to disseminate knowledge gained through Multi-INT experimentation**

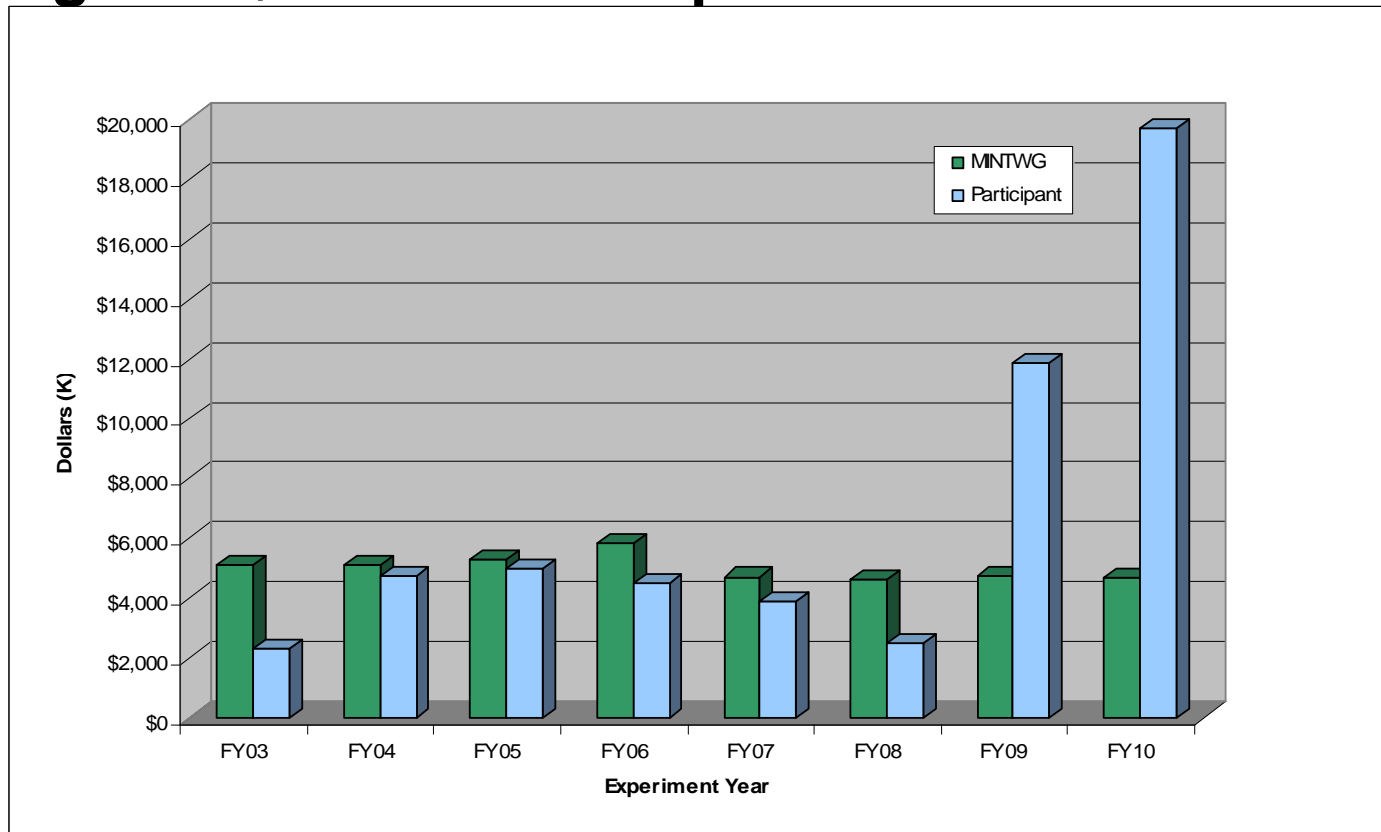

- Starting in 2003, the MINTWG has provided a yearly budget of \$5M to fund experiments

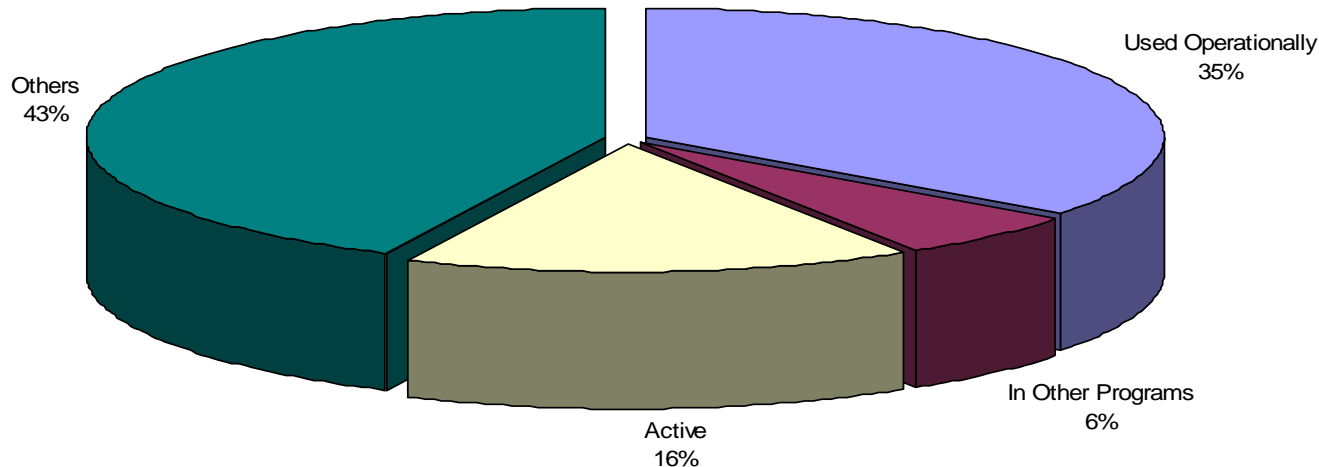

Enduring Impact of MINTWG Experimentation

- **Results of the Alumni Data Call, FY03 – FY09**
 - Canvassed all past (63) MINTWG funded experiments
 - 55% of the MINTWG funding spent on experiments resulted in an Enduring IC Impact
 - 11 distinct NIPF topics have been addressed by experiments



57% of completed experiments resulted in an Enduring IC Impact
